If anybody asks what Councilman Fant's done , here's the short list from his first two years on County Council

- ❖ **Stopped all re-zoning efforts not compatible with community needs or with high risk of displacing current residents:**
 - CZ-2017-17: Request rezone of 42.8 acres on Anderson Road for Mobile Home Park (BLOCKED)
 - CZ-2017-19: Request rezone of single-family resident on White Horse Road for Used Car Lot (BLOCKED)
 - CZ-2017-22: Request rezone of property at Antioch Church Road for +200K Housing Development (BLOCKED)
- ❖ **Instrumental in establishing moratorium on used car lots from White Horse Road to Travelers Rest**
- ❖ **Drafted strategy for county's long-term land use and development needs**
- ❖ **Instrumental in driving Council's focus on county's affordable housing needs:**
 - Chaired County Council's Affordable Housing Ad Hoc Committee:
 - On recommendation of commissioned study, \$5M revolving loan fund implemented for affordable housing initiatives
 - Secured 50% reduction of building/permit fees for house construction <\$160,000
 - Havenhill & Huffcreek subdivisions now in planning
- ❖ **Instrumental in convincing US Department of Commerce to create 3 Opportunity Zones in Greenville County for economic investment and job creation**
- ❖ **Leveraged position on county's Finance committee to bring \$73M of economic investment to District 25**
- ❖ **Initiated the discussion on the need to expand water and sewer from Southern Connector down Hwy 25 to Hwy 418 to allow for more industrial and commercial development in Greenville County**
- ❖ **Pushed for county ordinance to close night clubs 2 a.m. as a means of curbing late night gun violence in the community**
- ❖ **In response to the Augusta Road Hotel Crisis in which 100+ homeless families were displaced , worked in conjunction with Greenville Homeless Alliance and County Planning Department to establish an emergency relocation plan for impacted residents in case of a future event**
